

## Nor-Gwyn Pool Rules

Welcome to the Nor-Gwyn Pool. The rules below are designed to keep you safe and assure a welcoming and safe environment for everyone.

1. Be respectful of our facility and courteous to everyone. Please listen to the lifeguards and management. They are here to keep you safe!
2. Your membership ID card is required for admittance each time you come to the pool.
3. If you have guests, please pay at the front booth and be sure they get a wristband for the day. Sponsoring members are required to accompany their guests while at the pool.
4. Children under 12 must be accompanied – and monitored – by a responsible adult. Our guards are here to watch patrons in the water and keep them safe.
5. You are welcome to bring food and drinks into the facility. However, NO GLASS CONTAINERS or alcoholic beverages are permitted inside the facility at any time. Management reserves the right to inspect coolers and bags entering the facility.
6. Please dispose of all waste in appropriate receptacles to help maintain a healthy environment and control bees and unwanted pests.
7. No smoking or vaping on Township property or within the facility.
8. Please WALK while on paved surfaces.
9. The Pool's umbrellas may only be opened/closed by staff members. Their use may be limited by weather or other considerations and is at the discretion of the Manager. Please don't hang or attach anything to the umbrella.
10. Parents of children in a swim class or team practice are asked to stay outside the fence or under the baby pool pavilion. It is important for your child's instructor/coach to stay focused on the children they are working with. Please speak to the teachers/coaches before or after class when they are free to talk.
11. The only flotation devices acceptable for use at the pool are PFDs that have been Coast Guard approved; rafts and floats are permitted during specially designated events only.
12. Please make sure that everyone is healthy before coming to the pool. You should not swim if you have had a contagious illness (such as pink eye or stomach/intestinal virus) within a 24-hour period.
13. Swim diapers are required for infants and toddlers who are not yet toilet trained.
14. Horseplay in the pool, on the WIBITs, or on the decks is not permitted for the safety of all patrons.
15. Pets are not permitted on the premises except for select events.
16. Young children must pass a swim test to use the slides, diving boards or WIBITs. After passing this test they will be given a wristband that they must wear when at the pool to indicate to the staff that the child has successfully completed the deep-water requirements. Lost wristbands may be replaced for a fee.
17. The staff reserves the right to take away the deep-water wristband if the child must be assisted by a guard because they are unable to use the equipment on their own.
18. Diving boards: Jumps or dives must be straight forward (not to the side), one bounce is permitted, one person on the diving board at a time, wait until the person in front of you exits the pool before diving, exit the pool at the ladder closest to the diving board, do not touch the fulcrum (rotating wheel) on the board.
19. WIBIT rules are posted on the bulletin board.
20. Proper swim attire is required when in the pools; no street clothes in the pools. Those who cannot wear ordinary swim attire for religious or other reasons are requested to wear attire made of non-absorbent material (lycra, nylon, etc.) as absorbent materials (cotton, etc.) break down in the water and will damage the pool filters.
21. Any behavior endangering yourself or other patrons, we may need to ask you to leave the facility and your membership could be suspended or terminated.
